

UTSOA 2019 Graduates: BSID CIDA Student Achievement

ATTRITION/RETENTION

BSID Freshmen: Seven freshmen began in fall 2015 as Interior Design majors; six students (85.7%) remained after the first year. Attrition out of the BSID program after the first year was 14.3% (one student); this student transferred into a major outside of the School of Architecture.

BSID Transfer students: Four internal transfer students joined the first-year cohort in fall 2015 and three remained with the BSID (75% retention of internal transfer student).

GRADUATION RATES

Nine students graduated with the BSID in 2019. Two of the nine graduates were in the fall 2015 freshman cohort and graduated within four years of entering UT. Of the remaining seven graduates, one student was in the fall 2014 freshman cohort, four entered the Interior Design major as internal transfer students after fall 2015, one entered the Interior Design major as an internal transfer student during summer 2014, and one was a returning student (i.e. entered the school prior to fall 2015 and returned after an extended break); thus, they were not in the fall 2015 first-year cohort.

JOB PLACEMENT RATES

Approximately six months after graduation, a portion of the BSID graduates responded to the Career Services' Employments Survey and indicated having entered the design profession at the entry level.
